Healthcare

Billing Fraud

• Medical provider knowingly submits false medical bills by billing for services not rendered, billing for wrong procedure codes or billing for procedures of a medical necessity when procedures may have been elective or cosmetic in nature and not covered by health insurance.

Embezzlement

• Theft or misappropriation of funds placed in one's trust or belonging to one's employer.

Disability

 Claim submitted against disability insurance policy where the claim is entirely false or the claimant exaggerates their injury.

Identity Theft

• Using another's identity to secure health care benefits.

Immunization Fraud

• False billings by medical providers for immunizations that were not given.

Pharmacy

· Pharmacy inflates bills or falsifies codes.

Surgery Center Fraud

• Any alleged fraudulent activity (billing fraud, etc.) pertaining to outpatient surgery centers.

Unlawful Solicitations / Referral

• Denotes cases where patients are recruited and given incentives to undergo medical procedures, whether those procedures were actually performed or not.
