

Training

The California Department of Insurance, Enforcement Branch is a California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) participating agency. Investigators are fully sworn peace officers, as designated by Penal Code §830.3(i). The following list includes a sampling of the POST mandated and agency specific continuous professional training our peace officers receive.



Academy

Applicants must have completed a Regular Basic Academy or Specialized Investigator Basic Course, or be eligible to attend a Regular Basic Police Academy upon hire.

Field Training Program

Three 45 day phases of on-the-job training with a Field Training Officer.



Basic Investigator Course (BIC)

Agency specific training to familiarize Investigators with the various insurance fraud programs, agency policy and procedures, investigative techniques, building-entry, surveillance/undercover operations, and more.
