**NOTICE OF RENEWAL OF
CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY PROCEDURES****To: Firefighter, Police Officer, or Peace Officer Benefit and Relief Associations and Interested Persons****Date: February 4, 2019****Subject: Firefighter, Police Officer, or Peace Officer Benefit and Relief Associations Renewal of Certificate of Authority**

California Insurance Code §11401 was amended effective January 1, 2019, to require a firefighter, police officer or peace officer benefit and relief association (“Association”) to renew its Certificate of Authority on or before **July 1, 2019**. (See CIC §11401 et seq.)

After July 1, 2019, an Association must renew its Certificate of Authority every five years from the date it previously renewed its Certificate of Authority.

Any Association that wishes to renew its Certificate of Authority must do so in writing and send its request to:

The Insurance Commissioner may revoke the Certificate of Authority for an Association that fails to renew its Certificate of Authority, after giving reasonable written notice mailed to the last address of the Association registered with the Department of Insurance.

The Commissioner may also revoke the Certificate of Authority for an Association that has a dissolved, suspended or otherwise inactive status according to the records of the Secretary of State, after giving reasonable, written notice mailed to the last address of the Association registered with the Department.

If an Association wishes to obtain a reissue of a Certificate of Authority that the Commissioner has revoked, it must apply to the Commissioner and pay a filing fee of \$1,410.
