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ORDER

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18 WHEREAS, on January 1, 2009, the Insurance Commissioner (hereafter
19 “Commissioner”) issued a Certificate of Registration, #OG43568, to MICHAEL ALLEN
20 LANGGLE (hereafter “LANGGLE”) to act as a Title Marketing Representative in the State of
21 California, pursuant to §12418.1 of the California Insurance Code; and,

22 WHEREAS, on or about February 4, 2010, the Commissioner caused to be served upon
23 LANGGLE an Accusation, Notice of Noncompliance, and Demand, denominated “In the Matter
24 of the Certificate of Registration of MICHAEL ALLEN LANGGLE, Respondent,” File No.
25 DISP-2010-00047 (hereafter “Accusation”). Said Accusation is incorporated herein by reference,
26 and alleged that LANGGLE engaged in unlawful rebate activities in violation of California
27 Insurance Code §§12404, 12405, and 12408.5; and,

1 WHEREAS, the provisions of Article 6, Division 2, Part 6, Chapter 1 (commencing with
2 §12404) of the California Insurance Code apply to holders of a Certificate of Registration and,
3 further, that the Commissioner can bring an administrative action against a Title Marketing
4 Representative for any violation of the provisions of the afore-mentioned Article 6, pursuant to
5 §12418.4 of the California Insurance Code; and,

6 WHEREAS, LANGGLE has executed a Stipulation and Waiver in which he waived his
7 rights to a hearing in this matter, and any other rights which may be accorded pursuant to the
8 provisions of the California Administrative Procedure Act (Government Code §§11500-11528)
9 and the California Insurance Code, and has stipulated to the entry of this Order. Said Stipulation
10 and Waiver is incorporated herein by reference; and,

11 GOOD CAUSE APPEARING,

12 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that LANGGLE shall Cease and Desist from engaging in
13 activities in violation of, or noncompliant with, Article 6, Division 2, Part 6, Chapter 1
14 (commencing with §12404) of the California Insurance Code; and,


15 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that LANGGLE shall comply with the provisions of
16 California Insurance Code §§12404, 12405, and 12408.5 prohibiting illegal rebate/inducement
17 activities; and,

18 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that LANGGLE'S Certificate of Registration as a Title
19 Marketing Representative shall be suspended for fifteen (15) days, commencing on
20 March 22, 2010, pursuant to California Insurance Code §12418.4; and,

21 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order shall become effective immediately upon the
22 date set forth below.
