Jeff Sakaguchi is a seasoned executive, strategist and business advisor. He is a founding member of the board of directors and chairman of the Compensation Committee for ACT Holdings, Inc., a privately-held business process outsourcing company in debt collection, call center management, and revenue-cycle management. Jeff serves as the lead independent director and chairman of the

Governance Committee for True Blue, Inc., a publicly-traded staffing and recruitment process outsourcing company. He is a member of, and formerly chaired, the Innovation & Technology Committee, and also is a member of the Compensation Committee. Jeff is also a member of the board of Eccentex, Inc., a privately-held early-stage software company, and was formerly the chairman of the board of Neah Power Systems, an advanced battery and fuel cell development and manufacturing company.

Jeff is a member and former chairman of the board of directors of the Los Angeles Region of the American Red Cross, and is chairman of the Biomedical Services Committee. He also serves on the Board Governance, Philanthropy, and PrepareSoCal committees. He is also an appointed member of the National Philanthropic Board of the American Red Cross.

Previously, Jeff was the President and Chief Operating Officer for Evolution Robotics Retail, an early-stage technology company, and a senior partner with Accenture, a global management consulting and technology company. Prior to that, he was a senior engagement manager for McKinsey & Company, a global management consulting firm. He was also an engineering manager with Chevron Corporation, was an appointed Commissioner of the White House Initiative on Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders, and is a member of the National Association of Corporate Directors.
