Insurance Diversity Task Force

The Insurance Diversity Task Force is appointed by the Insurance Commissioner. The Task Force meets quarterly to consider and make recommendations about diversity in the insurance industry. Specifically, the mission of the Task Force is to:

- Identify and promote insurance companies that are actively engaged in diversity issues;
- Explore the status of diverse representation on insurance company governing boards;
- Identify actions that the Department of Insurance can take to encourage insurance companies to increase procurement with diverse suppliers; and
- Provide recommendations in regards to current legislation and suggest changes to existing law.

The Commissioner appoints Task Force members. Members serve two-year terms; Task Force members are subject to the reappointment process prior to the completion of <u>every</u> two year term served.
