Reviewed the Life and the Life-Limited to the Payment of Funeral and Burial Expenses Objectives and Revised AHS Curriculum The California Department of Insurance (Department), with assistance from the Insurance Commissioner's appointed Curriculum Board, recently completed a thorough review of the Life Agent Educational Objectives, the Accident and Health or Sickness (AHS) Educational Objectives, and the Life-Limited to the Payment of Funeral and Burial Expenses Examination Objectives. Revisions were only made to the AHS Educational Objectives.

RevisionThe AHS Objectives were the only Objectives that were
received. Those revisions include information regarding
Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS)
compliance and regulations, which include minor definition
clarifications on acronyms listed in the AHS Objectives. These

Instructions for Submitting New Prelicensing Courses	 Effective immediately, prelicensing education providers submitting a new prelicensing course or courses must submit all of the following required items to the Department: 1) Completed Prelicensing/Continuing Education Program Course 2) Course Approval Application, LIC 446-3, for each course 3) Filing fee of \$83 for each course 4) Prelicensing course materials 5) Documentation with cross references between the updated training material and the revised Objectives
