SUBJECT: Revised Bail Educational Objectives

Revised Bail Curriculum	The California Department of Insurance (Department) recently approved the Commissioner-appointed Curriculum Board's revisions to the Bail Educational Objectives (EOs).
Revision Description	The revised EOs include information regarding the new Bail Fugitive Recovery Agent (BFRA) license. The revised EOs are available on the Department's <u>Prelicensing Educational and</u> <u>Examination Objectives</u> webpage.
Revised Examinations Effective Date	Updated license examination questions based on the revised EOs will be launched on July 1, 2023.
Actions Required for Education Providers	To prepare students for the updated questions, prelicensing education providers who have active bail prelicensing courses are required to update their training material and begin teaching from the revised EOs on or before June 1, 2023.
Instructions for Renewing Existing Prelicensing Courses	 Prelicensing education providers must submit their updated course curriculum to the Department at the time they renew these courses in addition to all of the following required items: 1) Completed provider course renewal letter, <u>LIC 446-38</u> 2) Renewal filing fee of \$41 for each course 3) Updated prelicensing course materials 4) Documentation with cross references between the updated training material and the revised EOs

Instructions for Submitting New Prelicensing	Effective immediately, prelicensing education providers submitting a new bail prelicensing course or courses must submit all of the following required items to the Department:
Courses	 Completed Prelicensing/Continuing Education Program Course Approval Application, <u>LIC 446-3</u>, for each course Filing fee of \$83 for each course Prelicensing course materials Documentation with cross references between the training material and the revised EOs
