SUBJECT: Updated 12-Hour Ethics and California Insurance Code Prelicensing Educational Objectives

Background

The Curriculum Board, appointed by the California Insurance Commissioner, recently proposed revisions to the 12-Hour Ethics and California Insurance Code Educational Objectives (EOs). Subsequently, the California Department of Insurance (CDI) approved these revised EOs. As you know, education providers must instruct their students according to the directions and content contained in the EOs. Instructions for Renewing an Existing Prelicensing Course

Due to the revisions made to the EOs, prelicensing education providers who have active 12-Hour Ethics and California Insurance Code prelicensing courses are required to submit the following items by the course's **renewal date**: (1) the completed provider course renewal letter; (2) a renewal filing fee of \$37 for each course; (3) the updated course materials; and, (4) a cross referenced document of the EOs that shows where the revised EO topics are covered within the course materials.

Instructions for Submitting a New Prelicensing Course

Beginning immediately, education providers submitting a new 12-Hour Ethics and California Insurance Code prelicensing course must submit the following items: (1) a completed Prelicensing/Continuing Education Course Approval Application, Form LIC 446-3 (https://www.insurance.ca.gov/0200-industry/0040-seek-producer-forms/0200-educationproviders/upload/LIC4463Course.pdf) for each course; (2) a filing fee of \$75 for each course; (3) the applicable checklist items that are stated on the course application; and, (4) a cross referenced document of the EOs that shows where the EO topics are covered within the course materials.
