Motors Insurance Corporation is complying with its obligation to file the report required by the Bulletins regarding any and all actions taken and contemplated future actions to refund or provide premium credits in response to Bulletins 2020-3 and 2020-4. The Bulletins are ordering all property and casualty insurers with business in California to make appropriate premium adjustments beginning in March 2020 because the projected loss exposures of many California insurance policies may have become overstated or misclassified as result of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Motors does not issue private passenger or commercial automobile policies in the state of California. The only coverage we provide in California is for Auto Dealer's Physical Damage coverage for vehicles stored and held for sale on the dealer's lot and the policies are issued to an insured in another state. Based on actuarial review there was no change in exposure and therefore, no premiums were refunded relative to commercial automobile physical damage coverage.
