WHEREAS we, the undersigned principals, being seven or more citizens of the United States a majority of which are citizens of the State of California, are desirous of forming a fraternal benefit society pursuant to the provisions of Article 3, Chapter 10, Part 2, Division 2 of the California Insurance Code and for that purpose expect to file with the Insurance Commissioner of the State of California a surety bond in the penal sum of \$10,000 as required by California Insurance Code section 11011 and to apply to said Insurance Commissioner for the preliminary certificate described in said Code section; and whereas, upon issuance of such certificate we, the principals, expect to solicit not less than 500 members for such society, as permitted in said certificate and as provided by law, for a period of not more than one year from the date of the certificate and such further period, if any, not exceeding one year, as may be authorized by the Insurance Commissioner, for the purpose of organizing such fraternal benefit society. On behalf of the society to be so organized we, the principals, shall, pursuant to section 11013 of said Code, collect from each applicant for membership therein the amount of one semiannual payment of six monthly payments in accordance with the society's table of rates as provided by its constitution and laws, and shall issue to each such applicant a receipt for the amount so collected. Such advanced payments so collected shall be held in trust during the period of organization until said society has been issued, upon qualification, a certificate of authority, or, in the event the organization is unsuccessful in qualifying for a certificate of authority, until the return of all such payments to the applicants as hereinafter stipulated.

NOW, THEREFORE, we the undersigned principals jointly and severally and an admitted surety insurer as Surety hereon, are held and firmly bound unto the People of the State of California in the penal sum of \$10,000, lawful money of the United States of America, to be paid to the People of the State of California for the use and benefit of interested persons, for which payment well and truly to be made we bind

ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators, a successors and assigns, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

The conditions of the above obligation are such that:

If the organization of the fraternal benefit society is duly completed during the term of extended term of the aforementioned preliminary certificate and the advanced payments collected pursuant thereto are delivered without diminution or misappropriation thereof to the society when it is regularly issued a certificate of authority by the said Insurance Commissioner authorizing it to transact business as a fraternal benefit society pursuant to Chapter 10, Part 2, Division 2 of the California Insurance Code; or

If organization of the society is not completed within the time authorized by said preliminary certificate and any lawful extension thereof and all advanced payments collected from applicants by the principals herein are returned pursuant to written order or authorization of said Insurance Commissioner to such applicants, respectively, or to the persons lawfully entitled thereto as their successors, as the interest of any such successors may appear; then this obligation is to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

This bond shall become effective upon issuance by the Insurance Commissioner to the principals hereon of a preliminary certificate authorizing them to solicit members for said society and collect advance payments and is executed by the Surety to comply with and the bond shall be subject to the provisions of Article 3, Chapter 10, Part 2, Division 2 of the California Insurance Code and to the provisions of Chapter 2 (commencing with section 995.010) of Title 14 of Part 2 of the California Code of Civil Procedure.

It shall continue in full force and effect until one of the following events occurs:

- (1) Organization of said society is completed and the Insurance Commissioner issues it a certificate of authority to transact business in this State as a fraternal benefit society; or
- (2) Said society fails within the time allowed by law to qualify for a certificate of authority to transact business in this State as a fraternal benefit society and the Insurance Commissioner orders advance payments to be returned to the applicants (or their successors in interest) and refund is made; or
- Organization of said society and issuance of a certificate of authority is not completed during the one-year term of said preliminary certificate or during such term and any extension thereof not exceeding one year as may be authorized by the Commissioner;
- (4) In addition, the surety may relieve itself of further liability hereunder by filing a notice of cancellation with the Insurance Commissioner and at the same time serving a similar notice on the principals. At the expiration of thirty (30) days after the filing of notice of termination, or upon the filing and acceptance of a new

bond, whichever even first occurs, this bond shall be canceled and the surety relieved of all liability which otherwise thereafter would arise hereunder.

Termination of this bond shall not relieve the surety of liability arising hereunder prior to termination.

The aggregate liability of the Surety hereunder on all claims whatsoever shall not exceed the penal sum of this bond in any event.

By executing this bond, Principal and Surety agree any action on this bond shall be instituted and prosecuted in the counties of the State of California, with service by U.S. mail as prescribed in the California Code of Civil Procedure sections 417.10 and 417.20 and this bond shall be governed by the laws of the State of California.
