**RE: Enactment of Senate Bill 1155: Submission of Insurer-Designated Email Address or Physical Address for Receipt of Time-Limited Demands Pursuant to Section 999.2 of the Code of Civil Procedure**

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The purpose of this Notice is to inform liability insurers and interested members of the public of the Department's implementation of Section 999.2(b) of the Code of Civil Procedure, as created by [SB 1155](#) (Caballero, Chapter 719, Statutes of 2022) signed by the Governor on September 28, 2022, that will take effect on January 1, 2023.

Pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure Section 999.2(b), as added by SB 1155, if the liability insurer provides to the Department the email address or physical address designated by the liability insurer for receipt of time-limited demands, the Department will post the information on its public website. The information will be posted at [Consumer Information \(ca.gov\)](#).

**The liability insurer may submit its designated email address or physical address for receipt of time-limited demands to the following email: [TLD.address@Insurance.ca.gov](mailto:TLD.address@Insurance.ca.gov) by December 28<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Any email or physical addresses submitted to the Department after December 28<sup>th</sup> will be posted at a later date.**

Pursuant to Section 999.2(c), an act by the Department pursuant to this section is a discretionary act for purposes of Section 820.2 of the Government Code.
