III: 2024-2026 Strategic Plan – Updates & Discussion

Chandara Phanachone, Chief, Office of Insurance Diversity & Innovation (OIDI) - CDI

- Overview of the 2024–2026 Strategic Plan, emphasizing the Department's renewed commitment through the recently established Office of Insurance Diversity and Innovation (October 2024).
 - This new office was created under the leadership of Commissioner Ricardo Lara to embed long-term, data-driven, equity-centered policy solutions within the insurance industry.
 - Explanation of the historical context, noting that the Insurance Diversity Initiative began in 2011 under former Commissioner Dave Jones to address disparities in supplier diversity within the insurance market.

Key Milestones:

- 2020: Codification of the Insurance Diversity Task Force with the enactment of Senate Bill 534 (Bradford).
- 2020: Implementation of the California Insurance Diversity Survey requiring insurers collecting over \$100M in premiums to disclose procurement and board demographics; and
- 2022: Statute has since evolved to reflect a minimum California prerequisite premium threshold of \$75M.
- Expansion under Senate Bills 534 and 655 to include reporting on LGBTQ+ and veteran-owned businesses.
- Supplier diversity-related objective of the strategic plan includes goals such as:
 - Increasing outreach and engagement with underrepresented business communities.
 - o Strengthening partnerships with state agencies and advocacy groups.
 - Analyzing procurement practices to identify disparities.
 - o Providing insurers with models of best practices.

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Discussion Topics

- The state's leadership through multi-agency partnerships, including the California Statewide Coalition on Diversity Initiatives and upcoming events such as the March 2025 California Supplier Diversity Symposium.
- Greater discussion around maintaining momentum despite national challenges, reaffirming California's commitment to inclusive economic opportunities.
- Encouraged members to contribute ideas for implementing measurable key performance indicators (KPIs) and refining supplier engagement tools.

IV: Future Meeting Agenda Items

- Members suggested exploring best practices from utilities and other regulated entities with established supplier diversity programs.
 - Proposal to explore legal guidance and resources for suppliers navigating regulatory frameworks.
- Future committee meetings will be scheduled between Insurance Diversity Task Force quarterly meetings—the next committee meeting will be scheduled around the week of April 28.

Public attendees expressed support for the continuation of the Task Force's work and reiterated the importance of California's leadership in supplier diversity.
