We also work with state and local government agencies, minority business groups and advocacy organizations to identify sourcing opportunities for diverse suppliers where possible. We are corporate members of the National Minority Supplier Development Council (NMSDC) and the Women Business Enterprise National Council (WBENC). We also support 24 NMSDC regional affiliate councils throughout the US and nine states through our affiliations with WBENC. We recognize the following minority / women and veteran business classifications as described by the NMSDC. WBENC and US Department of Veteran Affairs. Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) An enterprise that is 51% owned, operated and controlled by minority group members. Women-Owned Business Enterprise (WBE)An enterprise that, regardless of ethnic background, is 51% owned, operated and controlled by a woman or women. Veteran-Owned Business Enterprise (VBE) An enterprise that is 51 percent owned, operated, and controlled by individuals who have served in the U.S. military armed services. To be included in UnitedHealth Group's Supplier Diversity Program, we require suppliers to be certified as minority, women or veteran owned businesses by a third party certification agency. Such examples include: the National Minority Supplier Development Council (NMSDC), the Women's Business Enterprise National Council (WBENC), the US Department of Veteran Affairs or any city, state or regional third party certification agency.
